Requirements:

- To be in possession of the Master's degree in International Migration or Master's in International Development and Cooperation from the IUEM at Comillas Pontifical University
- The applicant must not have been in any internship contracts on the basis of the same degree title
- To be an EU citizen – residence and work permit
- Address in Spain (only the address)
- Certificate of fiscal residence in country of residence (document that each country requests to prove that you pay taxes in your country, in case you are not Spanish)

The Chair and the JRS will implement a preselection process upon receipt of applications. Preselected persons will be interviewed. The salary, covered by the Chair, will be 1.107,74€ gross per month.

JRS Europe is very much focused on monitoring the European Union's external borders, the protection and integration of refugees in Europe and to promote a culture of hospitality. All our research is oriented to advocacy. Our communication aims to disseminate the results of the research and to strength our advocacy work by promoting an informed and, as far as possible, engaged social base. Depending on the skills, abilities and interests the candidate could join one of the three areas of work: programmes, communication or advocacy.

JRS Europe is member of several networks of the civil society organizations based in Brussels. To participate in these networks is an important part of the advocacy work, besides the writing of position papers, statements or building common positions among JRS national teams. <p>Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be a citizen of the European Union. • Degree on social sciences, economics, sociology, political science, law or communications. • Good skills for communication, specially written. • Interest for social media. • Capacity for research and analysis. Experience on writing reports or academic papers. • English is the communication language, both oral and written. Candidates must provide sufficient proof of their level of English. An interview (Skype) may be required. • Knowledge of French is highly valued.
