On April 21 and 22, the “San Juan de Dios” Physiotherapy Meetings, organized by the University School of Nursing and Physiotherapy “San Juan de Dios” at Universidad Pontificia Comillas, arrive at their 7th edition.

The success of the latest International Meetings, with about 350 people enrolled and 50% of international speakers, encourage us to keep working on the internationalization of Physiotherapy. Comillas Pontifical University knows the value of excellence that international education provides and therefore, complements the education of all its undergraduate students with a compulsory Foreign Language Diploma (English) that prepares them to follow the content of these Meetings, which will be fully delivered in English without simultaneous interpreting and in Spanish.

These free of charge and informative Meetings will take place over the course of two days:

On April 21, when everyone is welcome to attend, the conferences will be held at the university's Aula Magna, located at 23 Alberto Aguilera Street, which can accommodate up to 500 attendees. On this day, the speakers, grouped in round tables, will give their presentations on the subject matter of Sports Physiotherapy and will facilitate discussion and scholarly exchange with all the participants wishing to do so. The aim of these conferences is to expose the attendees to the main lines of research being conducted by our international partners, with a special focus on their latest results and their relevance in Sports Physiotherapy.

On April 22, the speakers will facilitate workshops, involving both theory and practice, at the facilities of the “San Juan de Dios” School of Nursing and Physiotherapy in Ciempozuelos. These workshops will be addressed only to Comillas undergraduate Physiotherapy majors and will be held in the different skills and simulation rooms, as well as classrooms, reserved and fitted for this event. At each workshop, adapted to match the students' seniority, each speaker will have the opportunity to engage a small audience in exchanges about his/her area of expertise and main line of work. The facilitator will also provide the students with hands-on demonstrations and training to allow them to acquire and master new skills that will complement their concurrent academic work at Comillas.

Comillas would like to thank each and every one of the speakers, as well as the universities they represent, for their participation in this event. Undoubtedly, they are the pillars on which the value of these meetings rests and the interdisciplinary synergy of their contributions will certainly enrich each and every one of the participants.

We hope that all the participants will find the upshot of the speakers' selfless contributions as well as the endeavors of the organizing committee appealing and informative.


